GR. 12 STUDENTS & PARENTS

Applicants to JAPAN – <u>Document Request Form for Japanese Institutions</u>

Gr. 12 students preparing applications to Japan should contact <u>Mrs Kitagawa-Axmann</u> about the process. Note that ISD does not prepare general application packages with official documents for students and/or parents returning to Japan and that many Japanese institutions <u>accept official school documents sent directly from</u> <u>ISD</u>. We process individual <u>Document Request</u> packages for each institution and programme according to the form, which must be completed and submitted at least four weeks before the application deadline. Students should begin adding prospective institutions and programmes to their application list in MaiaLearning.

Senior 'Check out'

Follow the instructions to complete your Senior Check out by May 31st. This includes the '<u>DP Request for Results</u>' service and ISD <u>Alumni Registration</u>. The last required signature is from Mrs Massong, who will verify the check out form and return your school records. <u>To get a signature from your counsellor(s)</u>, please book 15-min 'Check-out' meeting: <u>Mr Layman</u> | <u>Mrs Mika</u> | <u>Mrs Kitagawa</u>.

• U.S. / Canadian Applicants – May 1st / June 1st 'Reply By' Dates

May 1st is the 'reply by' date for the U.S. and June 1st for many Canadian institutions. Students may accept <u>ONE</u> offer, pay the tuition deposit, and decline all other admission offers. As institutions have spent months reviewing applications and selecting students, <u>please acknowledge their efforts by replying to each individual admission</u> offer you received. Also, inform your counsellor of your final choice so that s/he can send your final ISD Senior School Transcript confirming that you have met all high school graduation requirements and will receive your ISD High School Diploma on June 10th.

• UK Applicants – Replying to Your Offers

June 6th is the 'reply by' date for applicants who receive all decisions by May 16th. Students may select a 'Firm' (1st) and 'Insurance' (2nd) choice and decline all other offers via <u>UCAS Hub</u>. UCAS will automatically decline all offers for students who do not respond by June 6th! Applicants who receive offers after May 16th will have a 'reply by' date of July 24th. For support selecting a 'Firm' and 'Insurance' offer, please <u>book a meeting</u> with <u>Mr Layman</u> or <u>Mrs Mika</u>. Due to the UK conditional offer system, applicants may accept <u>ONE</u> additional non-UK offer.
