



## 2020-2021 SAT/PSAT/PSAT 10 TESTING REGULATIONS

**IN ORDER TO PROTECT EVERYONE'S HEALTH AND SAFETY,  
PROVIDE OPPORTUNITIES TO TEST, AND ENSURE TEST FAIRNESS & SECURITY,  
ALL TEST-TAKERS ARE REQUIRED TO FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES BELOW.  
FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN BEING DENIED ENTRY TO THE TEST.**

- Students are required to provide their own mask or protective face covering, which must be worn at all times during an SAT administration.
- Students must provide their own hand-sanitizer.
- Students must observe a 1.5-meter social distance at all times: When entering the ISD campus; at check-in; before testing room entrances; during testing; when exiting the testing room; when leaving the ISD campus.
- Students must be able to affirmatively agree to these 5 statements:
  - In the past 14 days, you have not come into close contact (within 1.5 meters) with someone who has a positive covid-19 test or is presumed to have covid-19.
  - You do not have covid-19 or reason to believe you have covid-19. Symptoms of covid-19 include cough, fever, chills, muscle pain, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell.
  - To your knowledge, you are not violating any travel restrictions or quarantining requirements.
  - You agree to wear a mask the entire time you're at this test site and follow instructions from testing staff.
  - We have taken measures to help create a safe testing environment; however, it isn't possible to entirely remove the risk of covid-19 exposure. By entering the testing room, you're accepting that risk.
